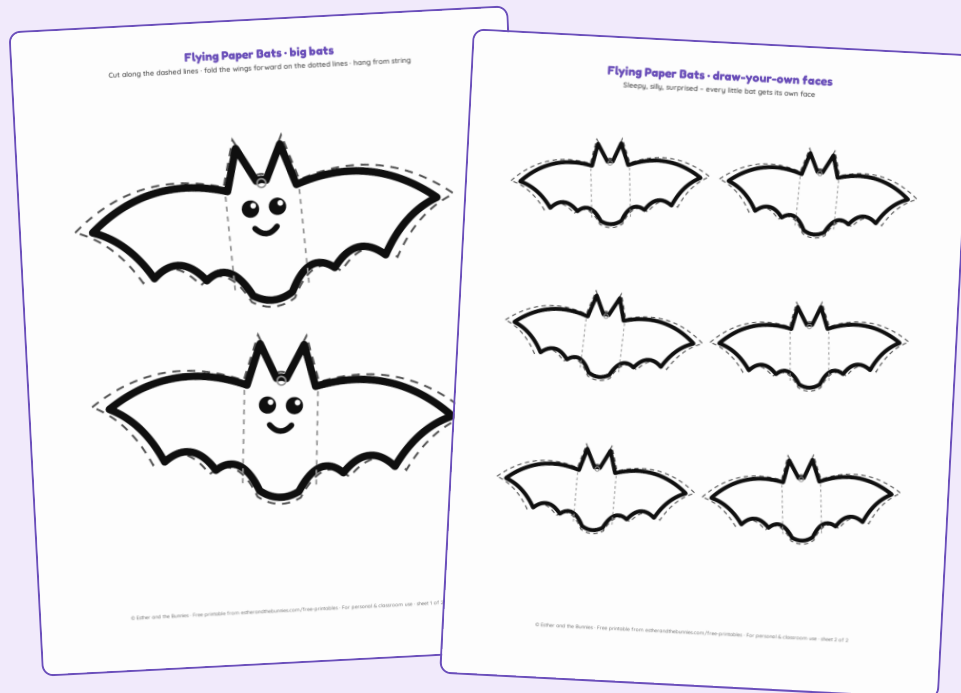


Flying Paper Bats

8 friendly bats to cut, fold and fly · Ages 3-8



How to use

- Print both sheets on regular paper or card stock at 100 % / “actual size”. Print sheet 2 as many times as you like.
- Cut along the dashed lines and draw the missing faces. Fold the wings forward on the dotted lines so the bat looks like it is flying.
- Thread string through the little circle and hang the bats from a lamp, a doorway or the ceiling – or tape them to a window. Little hands can color them first. Not scary. Promise.

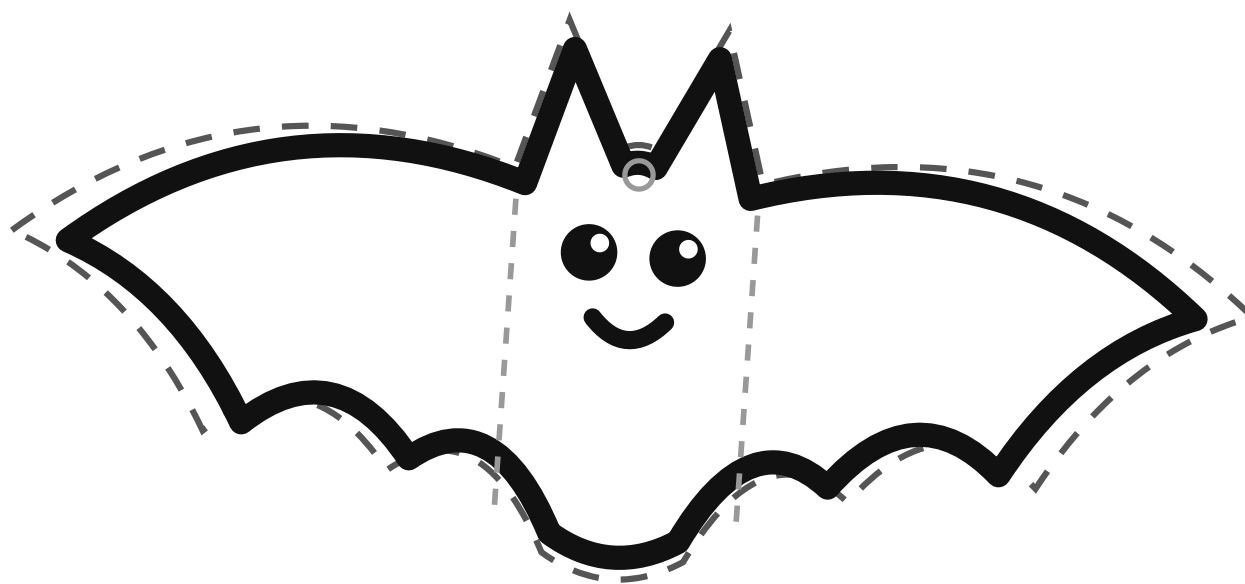
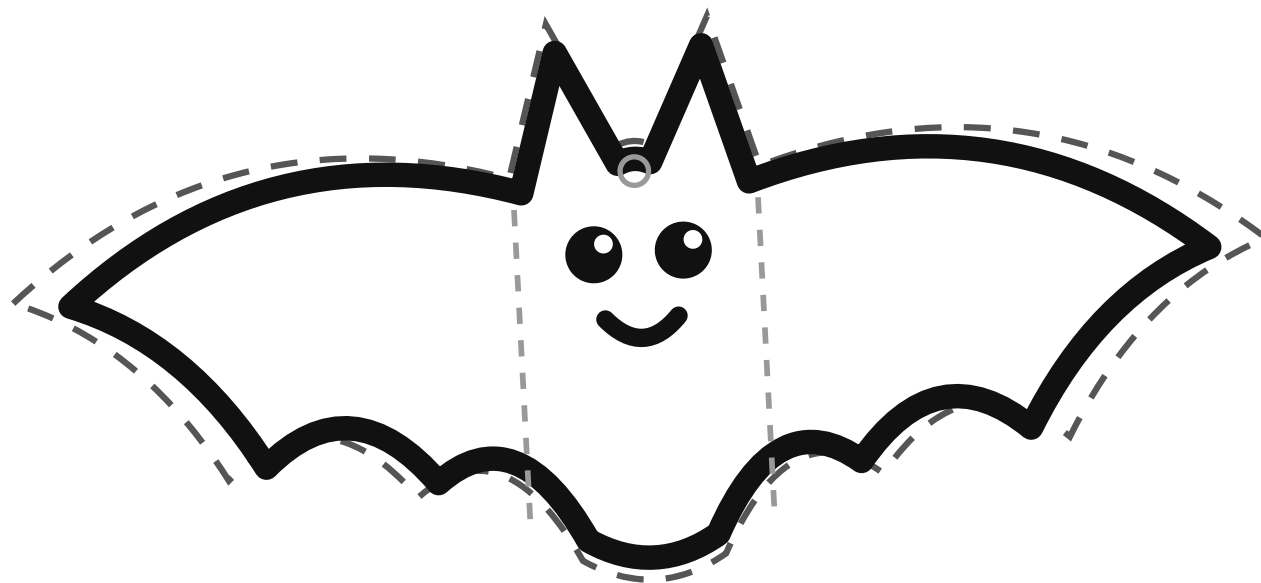
